


FROM THE EDITOR-IN-CHIEF...



There are plenty of dog walking trails near Woodfarm Barns – there's even a twenty-minute walk which begins right on our doorstep! Head next door but one to Crowfield Church, where you'll find one of the last timber-framed churches in Suffolk, as well as a quick and convenient loop trail.

Suffolk Beaches

Suffolk is a great place to bring your dog on holiday with miles of beautiful beaches open to the public year-round. Our cottages are just half an hour from the beautiful heritage coast, and plenty of our guests head there for walks.

There are no dog restrictions in force on Suffolk's beaches from October to April, so your pet can enjoy the benefits on any stretch of beach you like! However, some restrictions do apply during the summer.

DISCOVER SUFFOLK'S AREAS OF OUTSTANDING NATURAL BEAUTY

The UK boasts 46 designated Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONBs), and Suffolk is privileged to have two of them right in our vicinity! These AONBs provide numerous opportunities for both people and wildlife to enjoy the countryside, while also playing a crucial role in supporting the local economy and enhancing societal health and wellbeing.

Suffolk Coast & Heaths AONB

The Suffolk Coast & Heaths AONB is situated along Suffolk's stunning Heritage Coast, covering an area of 155 square miles. A rich variety of landscapes awaits, including marshlands, shingle beaches, estuaries, cliffs, heaths, woodlands, and farmland. Aldeburgh, Southwold and Orford are popular destinations, and the Suffolk Coast & Heaths AONB offers many dog-friendly beaches.



Dedham Vale AONB

Another treasure on the Essex-Suffolk border is Dedham Vale AONB. Known for its charming villages, rolling farmland, rivers, meadows, ancient woodlands, and diverse wildlife, this AONB is famously depicted in the works of artists like Constable and Gainsborough. Dedham Vale spans 35 square miles, stretching from Manningtree to within a mile of Bures.

Taking it all in

Both AONBs offer a wealth of activities for visitors. In the Suffolk Coast & Heaths AONB, you can observe a wide variety of bird species at Thorpeness, Walberswick, Orford or Sutton Heath. Visit the wellpreserved pier in Southwold, enjoy music at the Aldeburgh bandstand, or shop at Snape Maltings.

Dedham Vale is ideal for peaceful kayaking on the River Stour or exploring the landscapes that inspired famous artworks.

Plan Your Visit

Whether you're staying at our holiday Cottages, Barns or Barges, exploring Suffolk's AONBs is essential. These areas provide breathtaking natural beauty and a range of activities to suit all interests. WHAT TO PACK FOR YOUR DOG'S HOLIDAY

Far be it from us to teach you to suck eggs, but we've put together some guidance to be certain that you have their welfare, health and safety covered on your journey, and for the duration of your stay.



Unfamiliar surroundings might be simultaneously exciting and distressing for your Dog. So for the journey why not make sure you have something familiar from home, which will smell recognisable to them? Blankets, bedding and toys will do this nicely.

There are spray products on the market that will aid them while travelling, and you'll also need to have enough food and drink for the journey.

We ask that dogs aren't left alone in our properties, as the unfamiliar setting can be really unsettling for them. Bear this in mind when you're out and about as well.

If you're heading to us in the summer, or you are taking them aboard to Woodfarm Tuscany, then do take precautions to prevent sunstroke, sunburn, and the associated issues with parasites.

As we have said, we have a comprehensive inventory of accessories to make your travelling lighter and less stressful, but make sure you go through this list and check with us if you would like to ensure that we have any of the items available for you. 




VIDEO KILLED THE RADIO STAR...


